The training plans that you recently submitted per the requirements of 30 CFR, Part 48 Subparts A/B (underground/surface) have been reviewed and approved as of the date stamped on the enclosed copies. As noted on the plan you have been removed as an instructor on the underground plan, because you are not a certified IU instructor. Also please be advised your underground training plan has only been approved for 32 hours and the remaining 8 hours must be conducted at the mine.

Please note the mine operator is responsible for providing Hazard Training to all contractors who perform work at their mine. Also it is the responsibility of contractors and mine operators to provide Task Training to their employees. These two programs will not be included in a cooperative instructors training plan.

Any future changes or revisions to your approved training plan must be submitted to and approved by the District manager.
